

Rules for Participation in the TechGenalia 2026 Conference on July 9–10, 2026, in Warsaw

§ 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. These Rules set forth the terms and conditions for participation in the TechGenalia 2026 conference organized by GE Medical Systems Polska Sp. z o.o., with its registered office at Wołoska 9, 02-583 Warsaw.
2. The conference will take place on July 9–10, 2026, at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel, 21 Skalnicowa Street, Warsaw.
3. These Terms and Conditions apply to all persons participating in the conference. Any person who has received an electronic confirmation of registration or is present at the venue where the conference is held is required to comply with the provisions of these Terms and Conditions.
4. These regulations take effect on the date of their publication on the website on April 25, 2026.
5. The purpose of these Rules and Regulations is to ensure the safety, proper organization, and smooth conduct of the Conference by establishing rules of conduct for persons present at the Conference and their use of the venue where the Conference is held, as well as the equipment located within the venue.

§ 2. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of these Regulations, the following definitions are provided:

- a) Rules and Regulations – means this document containing a set of rules and conditions for participation in the Conference, available on the website at: www.techgenalia.pl
- b) Organizer – means GE Medical Systems Polska Sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Warsaw, at ul. Wołoska 9, 02-583 Warsaw.
- c) Conference – means the conference organized by the Organizer under the name: TechGenalia 2025, taking place on July 9–10, 2026, at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel, ul. Skalnicowa 21, Warsaw.
- d) Registration – means the notification to the Organizer of a natural person's intention to participate in the Conference by completing the registration form.
- e) Registration Form – means the form available on the website: www.techgenalia.pl, through which the registration is made.
- f) Registration Confirmation – means a message sent by the organizer to the email address provided by the registering participant during the registration process, confirming receipt of the registration and the start of its processing.
- g) Registration – means the successful processing and approval of the participant's application, which constitutes a condition for the participant's attendance at the conference.
- h) Registration Confirmation – means a message sent by the organizer to the email address provided by the applicant during the registration process, confirming the participant's registration for the conference.

i) Participant – means a natural person who was identified in the registration form and who has received confirmation of registration.

j) Privacy Policy – a set of rules and regulations specifying how participants' data is processed. The Privacy Policy constitutes Appendix 1 to these Terms and Conditions.

§3. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Registration, submission, and browsing the website require an Internet connection via a personal computer or mobile devices with access to the following browsers:

- Mozilla Firefox version 70 or higher,
- Google Chrome version 70 or higher,
- Safari version 12 or higher,
- Opera version 66 or higher.

§ 4. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Participation in the Conference is conditional upon submitting a Registration via the registration form available on the Conference website at: www.techgenalia.pl and receiving a Registration Confirmation, as well as reviewing and accepting without reservation: these Terms and Conditions, the Information Clause for Participants (available on the website: <https://www.gehealthcare.pl/about/privacy/privacy-policy?showPopup=false>) and the Privacy Policy.

2. Participants may only be individuals who come into contact with medical devices in their professional capacity as professionals; representatives of entities engaged in medical practice related to the use of medical devices; individuals who, due to their profession, position, or business activities, are involved in the distribution of medical devices; persons with medical or specialized knowledge who have received an invitation from the Organizer to participate in the Conference.

3. The Organizer shall not be liable for any incorrect or false information provided by the Participant during the Conference Registration and Sign-up process.

4. Participation in the Conference is free of charge.

3. To register, the Participant must complete and submit the registration form on the website by **June 15, 2026**.

4. The scope of the system's operations includes a service consisting of storing user registration data in a database, as well as managing such registration (involving the collection, recording, storage, updating, supplementation, and deletion of such data) by the Organizer.

5. Participants' admission to the Conference is based on the electronic registration confirmation received from the Organizer, sent to the email address provided by the Participant in the registration form.

7. The Participant is required to immediately, no later than 5 business days before the start of the Conference, inform the Organizer of their withdrawal from the Conference by sending an email to rejestracja@techgenalia.pl

8. Each Participant will receive a confirmation of participation—a certificate of attendance at the Conference. The Participant authorizes the Organizer to send the certificate electronically to the email address provided by the Participant in the registration form.

9. Upon registration, the Participant consents to the processing of personal data contained in the registration form by the Organizer or other entities acting on behalf of the Organizer for purposes related to the organization of and participation in the Conference, as well as for marketing purposes, in accordance with the Act of May 10, 2018, on the Protection of Personal Data (Journal of Laws 2019.1781, consolidated text of September 19, 2019). This consent also covers the processing of personal data in the future, provided the purpose of processing remains unchanged. At the same time, the Participant acknowledges that the Organizer is the controller of personal data and that the Participant has the right to access and correct their personal data, and that providing this data is voluntary but a condition for participation in the Conference. The Organizer informs that the Participant's consent may be withdrawn at any time, and the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent prior to its withdrawal.

10. The Participant is responsible for covering the costs of travel and/or transportation to and from the Conference.

11. During the Conference, the Organizer may organize a practical demonstration of maintenance activities or another practical demonstration. Registration for invited Participants will be available via a separate registration form. The number of spots for the demonstrations is limited, and participation is determined on a first-come, first-served basis.

12. The presentation will be conducted in Polish; the Organizer does not provide translation of the presented content into English or other languages.

13. Only participants who have received a separate invitation, expressed their willingness to participate, and subsequently received confirmation of registration for the presentation from the Organizer are entitled to attend the presentations.

14. The Organizer reserves the right to deny entry to the presentation to late Participants.

15. During the presentation, Participants are prohibited from recording video or audio or taking photographs.

16. During the presentation, the Participant is strictly required to observe safety rules and to comply with these Terms and Conditions and the instructions of the presentation hosts.

17. The Organizer is not responsible for ensuring that Participants possess the appropriate qualifications, knowledge, and competence to participate in the presentation. The Organizer will not grant Participants any rights as part of the presentation or as a result of their participation in the presentation.

18. Failure to comply with safety rules and the presenter's instructions may result in accidents. Every person participating in the presentations assumes this risk. The Organizer is not liable for any damages not directly resulting from its culpable acts or omissions. These Terms and Conditions are not intended to provide an exhaustive list of all risks associated with the presentation. In case of any doubts regarding the risks involved, please contact the Organizer prior to the presentation date.

§ 5. COMPLAINTS

1. All complaints by Conference Participants against the Organizer must be submitted in writing and sent via email to: rejestracja@techgenalia.pl or to the Organizer's registered office address, and must include: the name and surname of the person filing the complaint, mailing address, email address, phone number, subject of the complaint, date of the event, and a description of the factual circumstances justifying the complaint.
2. Participants may submit complaints no later than 2 days after the end of the Conference.
3. After the expiration of the above-specified deadline, no complaints will be considered.
4. The Organizer will review the complaint within 14 business days of receiving it and will communicate its position to the complainant in the same form in which the complaint was submitted.

§6. PARTICIPANTS' OBLIGATIONS

1. The participant is required to review the Terms and Conditions, the Information Notice for Participants, and the Privacy Policy and comply with their provisions.
2. Conference participants and all persons present on the conference premises are required to behave in a manner that does not endanger the safety of others present, and, in particular, to comply with the provisions of the Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions and guidance of representatives of the Organizer and/or the venue where the Conference is held, aimed at ensuring safety and order.
3. For important reasons, and in particular if there are indications of a threat to the health or life of Conference participants, the Organizer or persons designated by the Organizer may suspend the Conference or order the evacuation of participants during the Conference. Participants are strictly required to follow the evacuation instructions provided by the Organizer, persons designated by the Organizer, or security personnel.

§7. LIABILITY

1. The Organizer declares that the content presented during the Conference is strictly educational in nature. The Organizer shall not be liable for any damages incurred by Participants or third parties in connection with or as a result of the Participants' use of the information, knowledge, or skills acquired during the Conference.
2. In the event that the Conference does not take place for reasons solely attributable to the Organizer, the Organizer shall immediately notify the Participant of this fact.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the Conference program, to change speakers, and to cancel the Conference in the event of unforeseen circumstances beyond the Organizer's control. In the event of the Conference's cancellation, registered Participants will be notified.

4. Participants bear full financial liability for any damage or loss they cause, both on the premises where any Conference-related activities take place and at their accommodations.

5. The Organizer shall not be liable for damages caused by third parties or through the fault of the injured party. The Organizer shall not be liable for damages caused by force majeure or for the consequences thereof. Force Majeure is defined as an event beyond the Organizer's control that makes the fulfillment of obligations impossible or may be deemed impossible due to prevailing circumstances. Force Majeure includes, in particular: weather conditions, failures or disruptions in the operation of equipment supplying electricity, heat, or light; acts of war; or actions by state or local authorities regarding the formulation of policies, laws, and regulations affecting the performance of obligations.

6. The Organizer shall not be liable for items left unattended by their owners on the premises of the Conference (clothing, carry-on luggage, other items).

7. All views expressed in the presentations of lecturers or speakers reflect solely the authors' opinions and their own experiences. The Organizer shall not be liable for the use of material presented during the Conference.

§ 8. RULES FOR THE USE OF IMAGE, VOICE, AND STATEMENTS

1. The Organizer declares, and the Participant agrees, that the proceedings of the Conference will be recorded in the form of audiovisual recordings and/or photographs. During the Conference, the Organizer or third parties authorized by the Organizer may conduct photo sessions and film the proceedings of the Conference for the purpose of broadcast in the mass media (television, radio, the Internet, the press, etc.) or for the purposes of documentation, promotion, and advertising of the Organizer and other persons designated by the Organizer, as well as the Conference itself (commercial use).

2. The Organizer hereby informs that the recording of the works referred to in §8.1 will take place throughout the entire venue where the Conference is held, unless the Organizer explicitly designates areas free from recording.

3. The Participant authorizes the Organizer to use their likeness and/or voice and statements (if the Participant makes such statements during discussions, presentations, and/or on camera) and to distribute them as elements of the aforementioned works for the purposes listed in paragraph 1 above, and hereby grants non-exclusive and royalty-free consent, without any time or territorial , for their use by the Organizer and any entities authorized by the Organizer in all available fields of exploitation of the works, in particular:

- recording on any audiovisual medium (on video media, photosensitive film, magnetic tape, and computer disks, in a multimedia network, including the Internet),

- reproduction by any means,

- public display, playback, broadcasting, and rebroadcasting,

- lending, renting, or lending out media on which an image, voice, or statement has been recorded,

- uploading to a computer's memory and to a multimedia network,

- use on various types of websites (including the Organizer's website) and on social media channels.

4. By accepting these Rules and Regulations, the Participant consents to the use of their likeness by the Organizer or other persons acting on the Organizer's behalf, including reproduction by any means, distribution, and publication in the press, brochures, flyers, electronic media, the Internet, and social media in connection with the organization, participation, reporting on the proceedings, and documentation of the Conference, as needed. At the same time, the Participant acknowledges that the Organizer is the controller of personal data in this regard and that the Participant has the right to access and correct their personal data, and that providing such data is voluntary but a condition for participation in the Conference. The Organizer informs that the Participant's consent may be withdrawn at any time, and the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent prior to its withdrawal.

5. Acceptance of these Terms and Conditions and participation in the Conference constitutes the Participant's consent to the recording, use, and/or dissemination by the Organizer and its affiliates or entities designated by it of the image/voice/statements of each Participant in all promotional and marketing materials without any time or territorial restrictions. At the same time, the Participant authorizes the Organizer to grant further consent in this regard to entities affiliated with it or designated by it.

6. Granting consent is tantamount to agreeing that photographs, videos, or recordings made during the Conference may be posted on the Organizer's website or another website and on social media, used in promotional materials, and disseminated for this purpose via video or audio. The dissemination of the Participant's image, voice, or statements for the purposes specified in these Terms and Conditions shall be without compensation, and the Participant's consent is implied.

7. The image of Conference Participants may be recorded in video materials and photographs: in this case, the processing of the image is based on Article 81(2)(2) of the Act of February 4, 1994, on Copyright and Related Rights and does not require additional consent from the Participant.

§9. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The Organizer shall make the Terms and Conditions available prior to the start of the Conference.

2. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time.

3. Registration in accordance with paragraph 2d) constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Any new Terms and Conditions apply to persons who have not yet registered for the Conference or who have accepted the new Terms and Conditions.

4. The number of spots for the Conference is limited. Participation in the Conference is determined by the order of registration. Registrations for the Conference may be submitted starting June 15, 2026, and will be accepted until all available spots are filled.

5. The Organizer reserves the right to exclude from participation in the Conference any Participants who violate any provisions of these Terms and Conditions, and in particular:

a) engage in activities that are unlawful, contrary to good morals, or harmful to the legitimate interests of third parties;

b) take actions aimed at circumventing or indicating an attempt to circumvent these Terms and Conditions or the rules governing the Conference;

c) engage in actions that violate the Organizer's legitimate interests or damage its reputation.

6. The Organizer reserves the right, in the event of circumstances beyond its control, to cancel, partially close, shorten, or reschedule the Conference to a later date.

7. In matters not covered by these Rules and Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply accordingly.

8. Should any provision of these Terms and Conditions be amended or invalidated by a final court ruling, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

9. Any disputes arising from participation in the Conference shall first be settled amicably and then by the court having jurisdiction over the Organizer's registered office.

10. The Conference is a closed event and does not constitute a mass event within the meaning of the Act of March 20, 2009, on the Safety of Mass Events (Journal of Laws 2023.616, consolidated text of March 31, 2023).

11. The Privacy Policy constitutes an integral part of the Terms and Conditions. The provisions regarding amendments to the Terms and Conditions shall apply accordingly to changes to the Privacy Policy.
